

- Created technique of working with clients
- •Topic order is different from what she's seen
- Creates worksheets to guide clients through technique
- Another coach takes the order of topics but creates own worksheets and written content



#### Molly the Maker

- •Designs tops with quilt-like piecing
- •She designs the repeating patterns on the fabric
- •Another fashion label creates shirts in a similar style, but with their fabric
